(for New RPG students of 2021-2022 Fall Entry)

Points to note during course registration:

1. Make sure that you register MATH6771 during course registration.
2. Make sure that you register LANG5000 (Foundation in Listening & Speaking for Postgraduate Students) if you are of one of the following categories:
 - i) failed to take ELPA Speaking Test in their first term of study except those who are late for program registration or
 - ii) obtained a score **below Level 4** in ELPA Speaking Test
3. Make sure that you register MATH6900 (Mathematics Seminar) in consecutive semester and take course with code bearing **A** in the first semester, then followed by **B**, **C** and lastly **D**. 4. Make sure that you read carefully and thoroughly the following:
