Abstract

In the algorithm to determine the unitarity of an irreducible Harish-Chandra module, one needs to understand the character theory of certain disconnected reductive groups. This in turn is controlled by a finite-dimensional representation of a "twisted" finite Hecke algebra due to Lusztig-Vogan (generalizing their original work in the untwisted case) and made effective in the work of Adams-Vogan. The purpose of this talk is to given an overview of these results with a view toward some open problems.
